

Something To Think About

At the calling out of Lazarus, who had died, Jesus had instructed those who were present to remove the stone from the entrance to the tomb. John 11:41-42 says, "So they took away the stone. And Jesus lifted up his eyes and said,

"Father, I thank you that you have heard me. I knew that you always hear me, but I said this on account of the people standing around, that they may believe that you sent me."

If we will but look at this passage, we can learn much about our own prayer life.

First, Jesus gave thanks to the Father prior to the answering of the prayer.

Second, in a symbolic gesture Jesus, "lifted up his eyes". His focus was upon God and nothing else. Too often when we pray our focus is more upon what we are praying for rather than upon God. We can become distracted by what we want to pray for, rather than to whom we are praying.

The third thing we can learn is that Jesus prayed with confidence knowing that God the Father would hear, because He was coming before Him in humility, with a petition that was according to the Father's will. And because of Jesus' understanding of God's previous answered prayer, He could come before the Father with a boldness and assurance.

He concludes with the understanding that all this was happening as a testimony of God's work of salvation through Him. May we grow in our understanding of prayer and our relationship with God.
