Have you driven the area around your church lately. One of the most eye-opening things is the number of housing developments throughout the associational area. East Harris County and West Chambers County are

blowing up with new housing developments. That means there are a whole lot of people moving into the areas of our churches. Many of these moving in need to hear and know about Jesus Christ and what He can do in and through their lives. In his book, *The Healthy Small Church*, Dennis Bickers makes the statement, "The Institution of American Church Growth surveyed 14,000 church members and found that 75-90 % of them came to Christ because of a personal relationship with a friend or relative." Our best field of ministry and relationship building is in our own neighborhood and with those who live within a stones throw from our home. It is all about being Jesus to the world, beginning in the home and next door.

Currently, there is a new Church Start forming in the Mont Belvieu-Cove area called Trinity Bay Fellowship. The Church Planter leading this work is Pastor Thomas Cheevers. At the present time they are involved in front line evangelism, community awareness, and core group development with a launch date or first official service to happen in January. 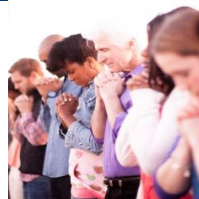

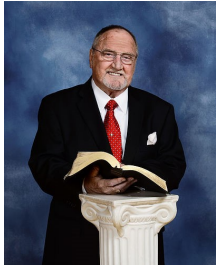

“Preach the word ... in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine”
(2 Timothy 4:2).

When the sun is hottest; when the rain is most scarce; when the days seem to linger, longer and longer; we hardly need a calendar to remind us what season we are experiencing. These are called, “the dog days of summer”; at least named so in the East Texas area, deep in the pine thickets, close by the Sabine River. The town is considered small, about five thousand people called Center, TX because it was in the center of Shelby County.

This was the home we loved and we shouted loud and fought hard to prove ourselves every Friday night on the Center High School football field. Sometimes we won a game. The team members became famous, and their names were printed in our weekly newspaper. I remember those events of the 1950s, but these were yesterday’s realities. We attended our churches back then, the whole family! We raised our children to behave in church and in school. The family would listen to God’s preacher and practice his instructions. The youth said, “Yes, Sir” and “Yes, Ma’am” to all adults. Our citizens respected the rule of law for America. Our children were raised to become strong adults and leaders.

Today the world continues to change. Church attendance is not a priority. Little Bible teaching and prayer occurs in homes. Christians are often belittled publicly, privately, and on the job. God is mocked by our leaders. Some public schools are teaching liberalism that gives little strength to our young. There are terms and ideas used today that counter Christian teaching.

What to do? When to begin? Where to turn for the help that we must have to save America? The answer is given to you in the Bible: Second Chronicles, chapter seven, verses 14-15. God help you to pray, repent, and obey.
