"And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely" (Revelation 22:17).

Here we have our Lord's final invitation to man! The Holy Spirit is pulling at the sinner's heartstrings; once again, before the close of salvation; the loving voice of Jesus calls: come. Thirsty soul, come. Thousands of times over; the Bible holds some two thousand instances where our Savior calls, "Come unto Me." Gospel preachers have closed untold numbers of worship services, crying out: come to Jesus! Jesus saves.

After the singing, following the preaching, the promises, comes the invitation: one day your final call; the Holy Spirit's last supplication; your final invitation to know God's grace.
