

Consider for a moment – is everything you hear in the world today trustworthy, or godly? I heard one the other day that simply must be shared – consider how the statement below does, and most definitely should, apply to our Christian witness and educational priorities – whether in college or in one's own home.

"I tell you what I believe that the Bible has said, but you better read the Bible to prove or disprove the ideas being said." Alistair Begg

Note that never says that God's word should be manipulated to meet one's personal agenda or be identified as false, insignificant ideas. There is accountability in our speech. The words contained in our Bible are true and written for our welfare, education, and encouragement - and must be stated clearly and honestly to allow others to become familiar with the Bible. Period. In that spirit of prayer and honesty, the BSM has provided close to 100 Bibles to students and faculty in the past two years. The Bibles are "backpack size" and are easily carried into the classroom and accessible anytime or place. That is critically important. It is exciting to witness the response of those who immediately hug it...or those who ask if it can be shared.

I believe one of the greatest priorities in any learning environment is a knowledge of the Bible. There must be a guide for measuring the truth. There also must be a firm foundation on which additional knowledge and wisdom are built. The Bible is that foundation. Education is designed to enrich the mind, not to isolate it. Please pray both for the words spoken in the BSM and classrooms and for the minds who are and will be, encouraged to verify it.


