Let us Celebrate Jesus this Christmas Season.





"And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth" (John 1:14 KJV).

Isaiah foretold this glorious event 740 years prior to its occurrence: "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6).
