Each year the Southern Baptist Convention sets aside one full week for churches and church members to pray specifically for their association. San Jacinto Baptist Association began in

1947 when 15 churches came together to work together to do what no one church can do alone for the Kingdom of God. Today 46 churches have chosen to become part of the association community. In November of 2001, the New Association Mission Center was opened to serve the churches that had raised the funds to build.

In 1974, the Association purchased a former camp facility that today is made up of 26 different buildings on 150+ acres, with a 14-acre lake, two worship centers, and dormitories that can sleep 360 campers, known as Lake Tomahawk Christian Retreat Center. Over the years there have been thousands of young people and adults who have made their way to Lake Tomahawk and heard the message of Christ. Since its beginning, many have put their faith and trust in Jesus Christ or have sensed God's call into the ministry. We are confident this will continue in the years to come.

During San Jacinto Baptist Association Emphasis Week, the Executive Board has set an offering goal of \$25,000. The money raised will go toward Lake Tomahawk's refurbishing of the waterfront Tower Slide. Will you and your church be a part of giving an offering to help reach the goal so that the whole Lakefront will be available for use?

Together we can accomplish this goal!
