The temperatures in and around the Houston area are a reminder that summer is here, schools are out, children are playing, and parents are trying to find things for them to do. Here is a couple of thoughts. Summer is

a great opportunity for churches to reach children, youth, and adults with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Consider a Five-Day Vacation Bible School, where students hear the message of Christ. Or how about a Vacation Bible School for one day a week for five consecutive weeks? Another might be to conduct a Backyard Kid's Club in a local neighborhood, park, or apartment complex. And if that's not enough; How about a Mission Type Vacation Bible School assisting a smaller church? Remember, every day we have the opportunity to share God's love with the people around us.

Each year, beginning in July, we begin promoting the "Rio Grande Valley Stockings and Stuffers," along with the "Boys Shelter Christmas." Once again, we ask our associational churches to assist in providing especially "the stocking stuffers." This past year the group who went to the valley took with them over 250 filled stockings to give to the children attending the event of the weekend. In addition to the Rio Grande Valley stockings, we seek to provide Christmas for the boys who will be waiting to connect with family members in the United States. Through the years the Association has provided for as many as 164 boys. Consider using this as a Mission opportunity for you and your church to be involved.
