Before Bobby Worsham's home-going, we were talking about the subject of temptation. As we talked, Bobby shared his view and understanding of Eve's temptation in the Garden of Eden. He described it as a long

process with Eve walking around and around the tree, developing a path, while looking at the fruit, as Satan continued to entice her. That is just the way Satan seeks to draw us away from what God says is right. James 1:14 says in the New English Translation, "But each one is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desires."

Modernize that with the world we live in that is in such opposition to the things of God, and it is easy to see that it is not the blatant things that would draw us away from serving the Lord, but the subtle ways that a person can be "lured and enticed" to do what seems to be harmless but can be so destructive.

The writer of Hebrews teaches how important it is to have regular Christian fellowship and worship. 
