Something To Think About

The Mission Team and others from the Association are considering a mission trip to Honduras on October 12-18, to serve alongside the 61 Isaiah Ministries. If you are interested in a life-changing experience,

please let the Association office know as soon as possible. It takes time and planning here and in Honduras to make these trips happen.

I want to give you something to think about this month. In the Book of Acts the word "multiply" is used three times concerning the church. In Acts 6:7 after the setting aside of the seven men to assist the apostles in ministry, it says "And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith" (English Standard Version). In Acts 9:31 after the conversion of Saul and his return and escape from Jerusalem, it says of the church, "So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied." And finally Acts 12:24, after the Angelic release of Peter and the death of Herod says, "But the word of God increased and multiplied."

In all three instances, it was about the Word of God spreading and growing because of the proclamation or sharing of the Word to a world without Jesus Christ. It is about the Word of God increasing through the teaching and discipling of believers. It is about the followers of Christ partnering with God to see His kingdom enlarged. And they did it boldly and without fear trusting God's Holy Spirit to use and guide them. It is something to think about.

Remember, we are to "Fix our eyes on Jesus and Focus on His Kingdom Mission."




