I heard a new 'buzzword' on the radio today. **Scripture Engagement**. That epitomizes what we are doing in BSM each week. The *action of engagement* provides God's intent for His people by recognizing the meaning of even the simplest words (often overlooked) as used in the historical context. Taking time to focus on our Bible provides the tools needed to live as God intended. Reading too quickly or superficially overlooks the tools needed to grow in our faith, to understand both wisdom and one's ability to survive the challenges of daily life. It is a *Connection with God* that is critical for young adults facing the world's challenges—and the desire to direct attention to anyone or anything but God. One must choose to engage, and for many that is a totally new concept.
