What a wonderful month the BSM experienced in October! Attendance grew, we were invited to lead the "See

You at The Pole" event. Many visited with us for the first time and continue to join each week. In addition, students requested a time of in-depth, extended Bible Study to read, study, share and apply scripture! It is a blessing – and an adventure!

One discussion that led into a study of various verses included a list of the most used words in the English language - Then, Now, So, When, Yet, Let, And, But, If and Why! (Think about your expressions of emotion and ideas throughout daily life ... you may be surprised.) Become aware of the ideas our Bible is attempting to teach by using the words we are most familiar with. Note how many verses begin with those same words. It is important to see the words that follow – some negative, some positive, some profound, some even frightening. All important. It is filled with life lessons and written to capture our attention. Search verses that begin with those words and carefully read what follows. Also pay attention to the use of the one word that is most common as we promise to obey, or share the importance of the Bible with others, or acknowledge our own responsibility. It is often one single word "But." However, recognize also that one word: 'Behold' is the one that changes lives! It appears in the Bible approximately 1,500 times and is used to command people to notice something incredible. That something incredible is God.
