The SJBA Transition Team has mostly wrapped up its work processing the findings from the recent survey to identify the top priorities our association should be focused on and implications for operating. The team will bring to the annual meeting a proposal to adopt the following three priorities:

- Priority 1: Build connections between the association and our churches.
- Priority 2: Build support for association churches through specific networks and collaboration.
- Priority 3: Revitalize churches.

To accomplish the priorities, the Transition Team will make a motion that the following changes be made to the SJBA teams.

1. Maintain the Administration Team, Lake Tomahawk Team, and Missions and Evangelism Team.
2. Combine the Networking Team and Resourcing Team and rename it the Congregational Strengthening Team.
3. Create a Pastoral Development Team.

A presentation will be made at the annual meeting summarizing the findings, including explanations of the above items.
