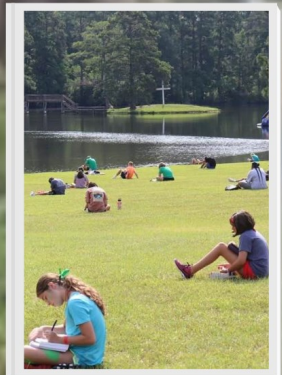
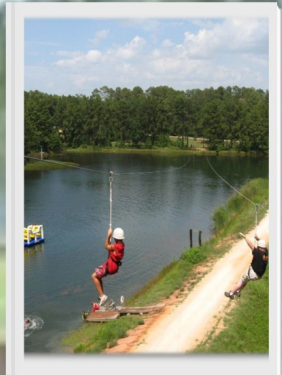

Think about the last time you experienced genuine hope – not just optimism, but something that steadied your soul in a storm? As the new moderator of our association, I wanted to begin by turning our attention to that very thing: Hope. It’s something our association needs, our churches need, and something you and I need. 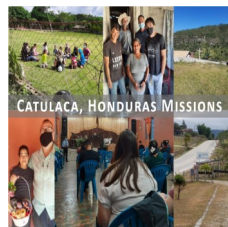
