Summer is off to a great start. Many of you have already enjoyed a week of VBS, and others will soon. Summer also means camp season. Since early June, Lake Tomahawk CRC has been buzzing with children and students. As I write this article, 64 students and sponsors from churches across our association are spending the week at camp – building friendships, enjoying activities, growing in their faith, and encountering the living Christ through worship and the Word. In just a few weeks, our preteens will have their turn to experience camp as well.

One of the greatest privileges we have is sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with the next generation. The Psalms repeatedly remind us of this incredible responsibility.

"We will not hide them from their children, but tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done" (Ps. 78:4). "I will sing of the steadfast love of the LORD forever; with my mouth I will make known your faithfulness to all generations" (Ps. 89:1). "One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts" (Ps. 145:4).

Praise God for VBS and camps where kids and students hear the gospel, and many respond to the saving work of Jesus! Praise God for lives that are being changed for eternity!

Yet the responsibility of telling the coming generation about the glorious deeds of the Lord doesn't belong only to VBS leaders and camp staff. It belongs to every follower of Christ. Parents, grandparents, mentors, pastors & staff, teachers, deacons, small group leaders, and Christians of every age have been entrusted with a priceless treasure – the gospel of Jesus Christ.
