Every season of transition is also a season of opportunity. That is the spirit in which our Executive Board approved a job description for an Intentional Interim Executive Director during its July 20 meeting.

This is far more than a placeholder position. During a defined 12 to 18-month term, the Intentional Interim Executive Director will walk alongside our churches by conducting a comprehensive organizational assessment, leading listening sessions throughout the Association, and preparing a formal Transition Report for the Executive Board. The purpose is clear: to strengthen San Jacinto Baptist Association organizationally, relationally, structurally, and missionally so that we are well prepared to call the next permanent Executive Director and enter our next season of ministry with confidence.

At a future called meeting, the Executive Board will receive a recommendation from the Nominating Team for a Search Team that will prayerfully seek qualified candidates. We are asking God to provide a leader who brings both proven organizational leadership and the wisdom to guide healthy, intentional transitions.

As this process unfolds, we invite every church in our Association to join us in prayer: for our Executive Board, our Nominating Team, our future Search Team, and the man God is already preparing for this assignment. While leadership transitions are significant, our confidence has never rested in any one individual. Our confidence rests in the Lord, who has faithfully guided this Association through every season and who has already gone before us into the next.
